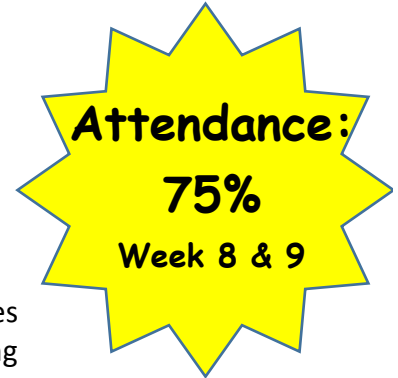

A quick reminder for all families that students will need to wear hats when outside during term 4. Now is a great time to find your hat at home or purchase a new one before next term.

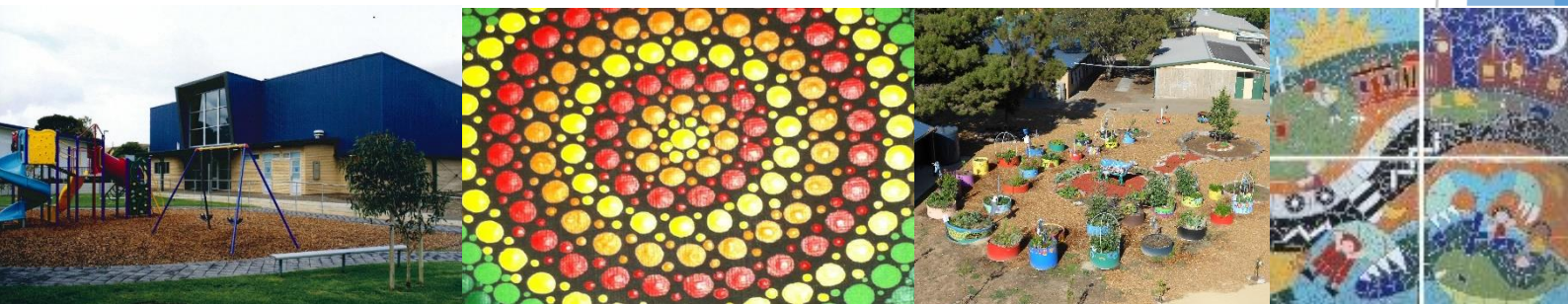

FUNDRAISING

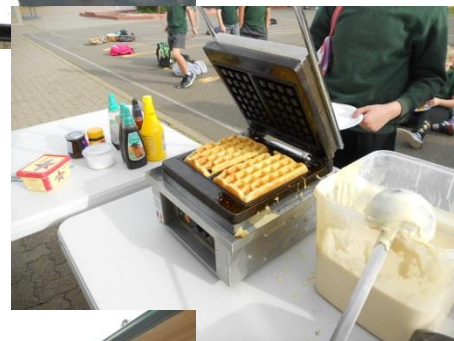
The FUNdraising Committee are holding a Colour Fun Run to be held next term to raise funds to assist in the refurbishment of the Library. Online fundraising is now up and running.
